chulucanas pottery

The village of Chulucanas in Peru is known for its distinctive style of pottery. Made with a traditional technique, the white parts of the design are covered with wax to protect them while the piece is exposed to smoke, which produces rich shades of brown to black. The result is pottery with a beautiful contrast, which is burnished to a shine with a stone.

Our Chulucanas pottery is made by Ernesto Balladares. He learned at a young age, and says "I love experimenting with the clay and firing and learning how to obtain different colors." Ernesto works with Manos Amigas, one of our Fair Trade partners in Peru.

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
