Shipibo fabric

This fabric is hand drawn by Shipibo (shi-PEE-bo) indigenous women in the jungle in eastern Peru. Each design is unique and is said to be an interpretation of shamans' ceremonial songs. Natural plant dyes are used to make the dark brown design, which is applied using a piece of metal as a pen.

Our artisan partner Grupo Emady helps preserve this cultural tradition by sewing Shipibo fabric into products which highlight this unique art form.

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
